There are a very respectable 50 covers in the set, and, whereas most of the Pan Am sets which were issued over the years were 30-strikes, this set is all 20-strikes. All have Pan American advertising on the inside and the movie of choice on the outside—although, as a veteran movie watcher all my life, I'd certainly question some of the film choices here! Where's Humphrey Bogart? My all-time favorite early actor isn't represented here, either—Wallace Beery!
