
I've always been interested in Trademarks. Perhaps it's because they're part of the industry's history, and history always rings a bell with me. They tell something about the particular manufacturers, as well, I think--What they specialized in...What their focus was, etc.

Collectors are familiar with most cover trademarks. If for no other reason, they're almost all categories in and of themselves: Cameo, Foilite, Filigree, Midget, Perfect 36, and a host of others. Box trademarks, however, are much less familiar to collectors, undoubtedly because few such trademarks actually appear on the boxes. American Ace, Pocketbox, Gem, etc. ...they're the visible ones, and so they're the ones everyone can name, but there are so many more. Here's a listing I've compiled over the years. It's not comprehensive, but it's good start.
