


Anyone collecting in this category would have to come up with his own parameters for what *is* and what *isn't* a qualifying cover here. For me, it can't be a Girlie, but the qualifications for what constitutes a Girlie cover are fairly set and obvious. Here, though, it's not so obvious. They're not going to say "adult-oriented", and many times you won't see "adult entertainment" and such on the cover.

So, how does one tell? For me, words or phrases such as "topless", "gentlemen's club", "adult club," etc. are dead give always. As can be seen on the second cover below, though, in some instances there won't be *any* clues in the text at all...but there *is* a suggestive graphic.

I have about 200 such covers in my collection as of this writing, but I'm looking forward to finding many more. When you think of how many strip clubs, etc. there *have* been over the years, and how many there currently *are*, there must be quite a few more covers out there I haven't stumbled across yet, but I'll keep my eyes open (!).
