KNOW YOUR COVERS!



Mirro-Glos was Universal Match Company's trademark for its covers glossy, laminated covers; 1941-?. These covers tend to feel heavier and stiffer, and they look great...as long as the plastic overlay hasn't begun to bubble or peal away. Sometime after 1960, Universal went to a different process to produce the glossy exterior; I'm not sure if they kept *Mirro-Glos* as the trademark for the new process.

There are actually quite a few, but only a handful actually carry the trademark. My collection numbers 1,991 at the moment...and I don't know a single other collector that collects them!
