A "footer," in case you're new to the hobby, is the text at the very bottom of the cover—"close cover before striking," etc. Not exactly a thrilling topic, you say? True, we often don't give footers much attention in our haste to examine the businesses, art work, and manumarks of the covers we're looking at. But, there are cases when the footer is everything!

Most notable, of course, is when the footer happens to be a 'Diamond Quality', 'Safety First', or other golden oldie from the past. In such a case, the footer *is* the defining aspect of the cover. Indeed, such old and distinctive footers are collectible categories, themselves, within the hobby. Even if you're not into the 'technical' side of covers, collectors should quickly acquire the habit of scanning both a cover's manumark and footer as part of any initial examination. Who know how many treasures have slipped through people's fingers simply because the manumark and/or footer happened to go unnoticed?
