Error Sequence

Now, here's something you don't often see-a whole sequence of errors for the same cover.



Actually, there are two errors here, both with the colors [Too bad this isn't in color—Of course, if this were on the web site, it would be!]

The background color here is supposed to be orange, and the darker box color and most of the text is supposed to be brown (The text on the side of the box is a much darker brown).

In the first cover, none of the brown has printed.

In the second cover, only the brown on the bottom part of the cover has printed (note the halffilled circle on the left).

The third cover has the brown correctly printed...but the orange background failed to print (only a thin partial strip just beneath the striker)

The fourth cover is almost there! It has all of the brown and *most* of the orange background, but it's still missing the orange on the top strip of the cover.

The last cover is just right! Everything's there! By the way, you should be able to see the staple holes in all of these covers, so these aren't simply production samples pulled at various points along the printing process. They're real covers!
