California, having the biggest population to begin with, is #1 by a wide margin, which is why there has always been complaints from the West that RMS wasn't paying enough attention to the...West! The problem with that is that California is basically isolated. It has ocean to the west, a foreign country to the south, desert states to the east, and a sparsely populated state to the north. So, collector-wise, the "West" is California all by itself. Whereas...

The Northeast, on the other hand, is the only area of the country that has multiple densely populated states all clustered together in one area. Thus, it has four states in the top 10 of the list shown here.

Again in the top 10, the Midwest, with states such as Ohio, Illinois and Wisconsin, is certainly well represented.

In fact, taking the results, here, on a *regional* basis, rather than state by state, the ranking would be quite different:

Looking at it this way, it's more obvious why almost all of the RMS Conventions have been held in the Midwest, Northeast, and Southeast.

On the other hand, it'd be nice to have a convention in places such as Anchorage, or Baton Rouge, or Phoenix, but it's just not feasible, based on numbers, if nothing else.

By the way, did you notice there are four states that have no collectors, or at least none enrolled in the hobby: Alaska, Utah, Mississippi, N. Dakota—all sparsely populated to begin with, but you'd think there would be at least a few there amongst all those millions of people.
