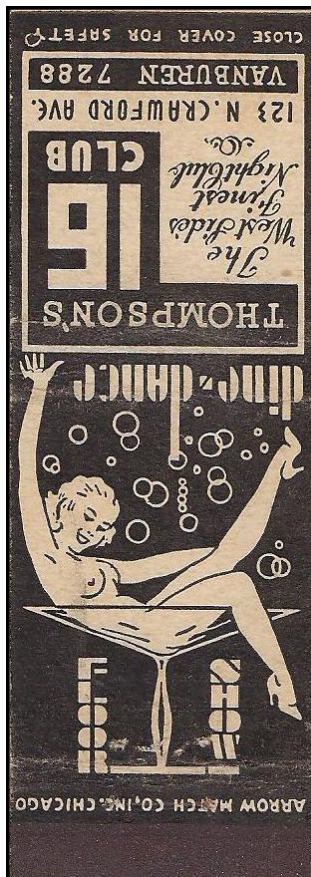


Stock
